Instructions for Submission of Research Abstracts

1. Abstracts of oral papers/exhibits should be submitted to email id <u>scoticon24@gmail.com</u>

2. Members interested in participating in more than one category should submit an abstract for each category.

3. Members will not be allowed to participate in category for which abstracts have not been submitted.

4. Authors should submit a structured abstract with headings:

(a) Title

(b) Authors (Full Name) along with details of Institution(s), City, State and Country

(c) Background, Objectives and Study Design

(d) Methods

(e) Results

(f) Conclusion

(g) Trial Registration, if any

(h) Funding

(i) Acknowledgements and

(j) References (not more than 2 latest citations)

(k)Keywords

The abstract structure should not exceed 350 words.

5. The content of the abstract should be accurate, brief, clear, organized, self-contained, and in American (US) English language

Instructions for Submission of Scientific Papers

- Papers are invited, which describe and emphasize the development in areas of education/academics, clinical practice, and policy decision making in occupational therapy.
- Registration for conference is mandatory for presentation
- The research work to be presented should be novel with sound scientific reasoning, and be pertaining to occupational therapy.
- Preparation of the study/paper should be based on "Guidelines to Authors for Submission" that can be obtained from IJOT website: www.ijotonweb.org/contributors.asp
- Scientific papers have to be submitted on acceptance of abstract to <u>scoticon24@gmail.com</u>
- Participants will be allowed to present only those research papers which are accepted and not any other paper at the last minute.
- Total time allotted for each oral paper presentation is only 10 minutes.
- Paper presentation in-absentia will not be allowed. However, in circumstances beyond control, the chairperson of the scientific program committee will use his discretion and may grant permission to the co-author, to present the paper in non-competitive category.
- Scientific papers under the competitive category will be peer reviewed by two experts in the specified field prior to the conference.
- The design of the scientific program shall be final and binding in respect to acceptance of abstracts/papers and also regarding allotment of time and duration of presentation.

Instructions for Submission of Innovative Technology/Minimovie

- Mini Movies should not exceed the time limit of 4 minutes.
- Recorded video of the use of particular innovation has to be submitted.
- Final Submissions of the videos preferably in .mp4 format should be shared to <u>scoticon24@gmail.com</u>

- OMG Provo Award for Humorous Poster (only two entries per college)
- Best Student DelegateOTICON'2024 Award by Karnataka Branch of AIOTA
- Gold Medal Award for best OT graduates of 2023 (By Orissa Branch of AIOTA).

Candidate graduated in the year 2023 and by the respective head of Occupational Therapy college/institute as per the AIOTA guidelines *(only two entries per college)*

Students' Submission General Guidelines

- Registration for the student's events is mandatory in respective competitive categories i.e., poster, street play and innovative technology.
- Faculty in charge from the respective college should send the list of participants in student's event with the conference registration numbers of the students duly signed and stamped to email id: <u>scoticon24@gmail.com</u>
- The number of student participants for each category should not exceed 10. Only 2 participants from the team shall be allowed to present the Poster and the Innovative Device

Student's OMG Provo Humorous Poster Guidelines

- The poster should depict the latest and/or novel information related to Occupational Therapy in an original and creative artwork in a humorous concept
- The humor depicted should not hurt/harm the sentiments of the professionals and the professions directly
- The size of the poster should be A3 with portrait orientation
- The poster should be 2 dimensional on a plain paper.
- No pop-ups or any hangings from the poster are not allowed
- Three dimensional Posters will be disqualified
- The poster can be handmade or digital
- In case of any violation of rules, the team shall be disqualified from the competition. However, the team may be allowed to present the poster under non-competitive category.

Student's Poster Guidelines

- The poster should be in portrait orientation with the size of 4 feet x 3 feet
- The poster should be 2 dimensional on a plain paper.
- Pop-ups or any hangings from the poster will not be allowed
- Three dimensional Posters will be disqualified
- Participants are encouraged to present evidence-based information to showcase the poster theme.
- In case of any violation of rules, the team shall be disqualified from the competition. However, the team may be allowed to present the poster under non-competitive.

Student's Innovative Technology Guidelines

Video or actual working of the device or the equipment needs to be presented during the judging. Innovative technology should be based on sound clinical and scientific reasoning.

Student's Street play Guidelines

- The street play should be in English or Hindi maximally
- Use of local slang and common expressions are allowed
- The use of placards is allowed
- No props allowed
- Should not involve any background music
- In case of any violation of rules, the team shall be disqualified from the competition.
